PART 5: TERMS AND CONDITIONS UPON ACCEPTANCE OF THE CULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP

These conditions shall apply to learners who are awarded a Cultural Scholarship:

- 1.1 A Cultural Scholarship provides a disbursement on academic tuition fees only and is credited to the recipient's school fee account. The full enrolment deposit, uniforms, books, study requirements, tour fees, stationery, musical equipment and other usual school-related expenses are specifically excluded from this disbursement.
- 1.2 A Cultural Scholarship is awarded to a learner who shows an exceptional aptitude in the area of Performing Arts.
- 1.3 A Cultural Scholarship is awarded provided the applicant successfully submits an online admission application for Rand Park High School via the Gauteng Department of Education's (GDE) e-application portal for the 2019 academic year. Supporting documents and a full application form must also be submitted to the School, in accordance with the GDEs admission requirements and the School's Admission Policy. Timeous e-applications are essential. Failure to submit an e-application and the supporting documentation may result in the scholarship being revoked.
- 1.4 Applicants must provide evidence of their success, including certificates and/or testimonials.
- 1.5 Short-listed Cultural Scholarship applicants, accompanied by their parents/guardians, may be invited to an interview if deemed necessary by the Scholarship Committee.
- 1.6 Recipients of Cultural Scholarships offered by Rand Park High School will be notified on or before 28 March 2018. A confirmatory letter, stating the scholarship offer, will be sent to the parents/guardians via email. The successful candidate will have seven (7) working days within which to accept the scholarship in writing. Should a written acceptance not be received within this timeframe, the scholarship will be offered to the next candidate on the short-list.
- 1.7 A Cultural Scholarship is awarded for a single academic year. Parents/guardians of the scholarship recipient may re-apply for the following academic year by completing and submitting a *Re-award Motivation Form* before the closing date. This form is available from the Scholarships Office at Rand Park High School in the Third School Term of 2018 and must be submitted by 28 September 2018. Late applications will not be considered.
- 1.8 A Cultural Scholarship is revoked if the learner is de-registered from Rand Park High School during the academic year.

1.9 A Cultural Scholarship may be revoked or reduced at the sole discretion of the School, if:

- 1.9.1 The learner fails to satisfy cultural programme participation requirements during the course of the year.
- 1.9.2 The learner fails to present him/herself to the Dean of the Grade when requested to do so in order to evaluate participation in school/cultural activities.
- 1.9.3 The Learner's conduct, attitude and behaviour does not comply with the requirements of the School's Code of Conduct.

1.10 The applicant, and at least one parent, should be South African citizens or have permanent residence. Rand Park High School reserves the right to request proof of citizenship.
