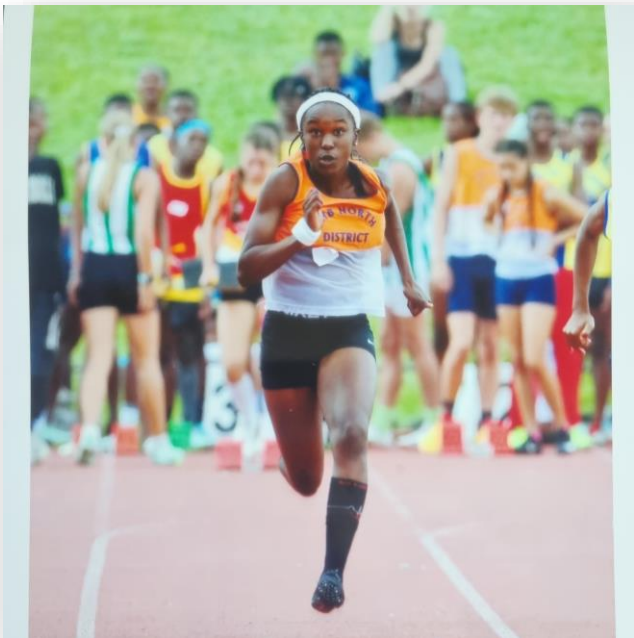
## Athletics
