## 2024 SCHOOL FEES

It has been approved at the AGM of the School Governing Body held on 1 November 2023 that: The Annual School Fees per learner, for Rand Park High School for the 2024 Academic year shall be: R53,500 per existing learner AND R55,000 per new learner.

Rand Park High School is a Section 21 Independent State School and therefore rely on parents paying fees as our main source of income.

**Please note:**

- The first instalment paid at the time of registration does not replace the January instalment.**
- A further 10 equal instalments, commencing 31 January 2024 are still payable**

1. Important information:

- a) School Fees will include all relevant learning area information and core notes, educational trips where specified as a compulsory element of the specific learning area and transport for learners who are selected to represent RPHS for the extra-curricular programme.
- b) Please note: textbooks, stationery, tours, excursions, plays or festivals offered by the school outside of the compulsory excursions as stipulated by the curriculum, school uniform, sports equipment and sports uniform and participation or entry for Olympiads, Eisteddfods, JSE Games and the like will however, NOT BE INCLUDED.
- c) School fees are due and payable annually in advance at the beginning of each school year and such payment is a statutory duty, which a learner's parents must pay and the parents (as defined in the South African Schools Act) whether married, unmarried or divorced are jointly and severally liable unless and to the extent of them being exempted.
- d) However, purely in order to reduce the financial burden on parents, TEN EQUAL instalments commencing January 2024 and ending October 2024 will be acceptable. Any other payment arrangements must be approved, in writing, by the Finance Committee.
- e) Failure to pay any single instalment, by the due date, will mean that the full 2024 School Fee amount becomes due and payable immediately.
- f) Parents who wish to be exempted from the payment of school fees must apply annually to the SGB.
- g) The income of both parents *irrespective of their marital situation* is used in the calculation of exemption.
- h) The SGB reserves the right to ask for any supporting documentation that they may deem necessary in assessing the exemption application.
- i) A maintenance agreement or divorce order *cannot* be enforced on a third party being the school.
- j) School Fees are a statutory debt prescribed by parliament under the South African Schools Act and do not fall within the National Credit Act 34 of 2005 and a result may not be referred to a debt counsellor for debt review.

When transferring school fees directly into the school's bank account, please use the reference number as it appears on the bottom, left hand corner of the school fee statement followed by the learner's name and surname as the beneficiary reference.
