REMINDER: EARLY RELEASE PROCEDURE

- 1.If it is necessary for a child to leave school during the day for a scheduled appointment, a letter must be handed in at the Front Office or emailed to tracy.stokoe@randparkhigh.co.za and/or rphs@randparkhigh.co.za between 07h00 and 07h30. Parents must collect their child at the Front Office at the requested collection time where they will be asked to sign a release form. Intercom announcements will not be made to call learners out of class.
