Speech & Drama Festival

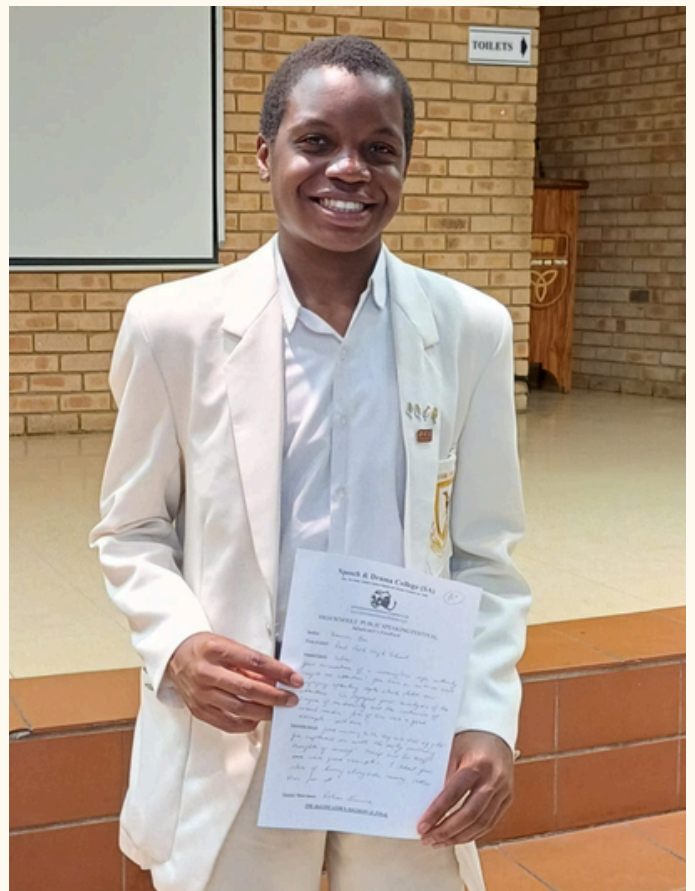
Grade 12 Individual Speaker Category
