5. SPORT SCHOLARSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Scope of award: The scholarship is credited to the learner's school fee account and applies to academic tuition fees only. The enrolment initial payment, uniforms, books, study requirements, tours, stationery, sports kit/equipment and other school-related expenses are excluded.

Eligibility and admission: The learner must demonstrate exceptional sporting aptitude. Any award is conditional upon successful placement at Rand Park High School by the Gauteng Department of Education (GDE); parents/guardians remain responsible for completing the required GDE admission application.

Assessments and evidence: Candidates in Athletics, Cricket, Hockey, Netball and Rugby will be required to attend the School's Talent Week assessments during November 2026. Applicants in other sports offered by the School must provide appropriate evidence such as certificates, statistics, race times and/or coach testimonials.

Selection and acceptance: Shortlisted applicants and their parents/guardians may be invited to an interview. Successful applicants will be notified in writing and must accept the offer in writing within seven (7) working days, failing which the scholarship may be offered to another candidate.

Duration and re-award: A scholarship is awarded for one academic year only. A re-award for the following year is not automatic and requires submission of the School's Re-award Motivation Form by the applicable closing date. Scholarships are reviewed annually to ensure continued eligibility. Re-award is contingent upon the recipient's active participation in the life of the school and adherence to all school rules and policies.

Ongoing requirements: The learner must satisfy the School's sport participation requirements (>80% of practices and matches/fixtures), maintain excellent sporting performance, attend progress reviews with the Dean of the Grade when requested, comply with the School's Code of Conduct and pass the academic year. Circumstances beyond the learner's control that prevent school sport participation will be taken into account.

Reduction or withdrawal: The School may reduce or revoke the scholarship if the learner does not meet the ongoing requirements. The scholarship will be revoked if the learner is de-registered from Rand Park High School during the academic year.

Early departure: If the learner leaves Rand Park High School during the first three school terms of the academic year, the scholarship amount will be charged back to the learner's school fee account and the parents/guardians will be liable for the resulting amount owing.

Allocation of award: The school reserves the right not to award any advertised scholarships.
